The Jeffrey J. Gusinda Memorial Endowment Scholarship was established through the Gusinda Charitable Remainder Trust. Officer Gusinda died tragically in 1993 at the age of 31 in an accident at the police shooting range in Milwaukee. This special scholarship benefits students enrolled in WCTC's School of Protective & Human Services, specifically the Criminal Justice Studies program. This scholarship is a beautiful tribute to Officer Gusinda's life and legacy.
